



























Analysis

The program curriculum has received excellent feedback, with 100% agreement on its coverage of contemporary topics and its focus on ethical and professional values. It has been highly

However, a small percentage (3.70%) rated these aspects as poor, indicating some areas for improvement in specific parameters like certificate courses. Overall, SVIMS provides a solid educational experience with a few areas to enhance further.

The parent's feedback indicates that the education at SVIMS has had a positive impact on students, with 96.15% of parents reporting improvements in their child's confidence and communication skills. Additionally, 90.38% noted a development in their child's overall personality, while 86.54% observed a more professional attitude. However, 17.31% felt their child's employability had not improved significantly.

The analysis reveals a mixed perception of the offerings at SVIMS and Savitribai Phule Pune University. While counselling and mentoring facilities (51.92%), infrastructure (53.85%), and safety aspects (50%) are highly rated under "Excellent" and "Very Good," areas like industry interactions (44.23%) and certificate/professional courses (48.08%) lag slightly behind. Notably, character-building education (46.16%) and the curriculum (46.15%) are appreciated but show room for enhancement. A significant portion, ranging between 17% to 28%, rated several aspects as "Fair" or "Poor," emphasizing opportunities to improve areas like education quality and extracurricular activities.
