WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY- ECO SYSTEM RESTORATION HEALING THE EARTH 06.06.2022

Resource Person: Mr. Arpo Mukherjee, Sr. Programme Associate, International Forum for Environment, Sustainability and Technology

Mr. Arpo Mukherjee apprised the audience about the state of our lands, the state of our oceans, wealth vs material consumptions, the climate crisis, the local challenges and the solutions that can be adopted to overcome these challenges. He spoke about ecosystem restoration – an important nature-based solution for food insecurity, climate change, and biodiversity loss. It is not a quick or easy process; it will require changes in the way we measure economic progress to how we grow food and what we eat. But the beauty of ecosystem restoration is that it can happen at any scale – and everyone has a role to play in it.

He requested everyone to write down their current and sustainable practices in context of use of transport, handling waste management, electricity, food, life on land etc. This exercise made the participants reflect on their actions and brought in a realisation that action rather than talking is required to save our planet. He urged the attendees to take the environment pledge and put it on their LINKEDIN profiles for better reach and practice of sustainable initiatives.



On 25th April 2022, all “Green Vibes Only” participants reported at SVIMS wearing their green outfits at 10:00 am with the following items -

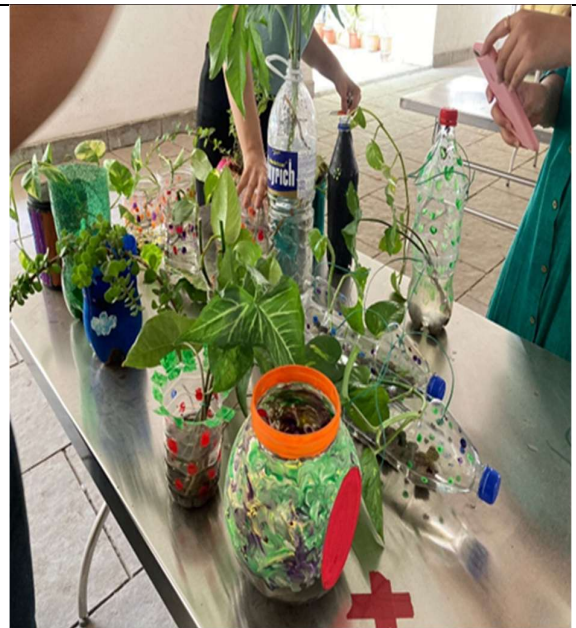
1. Hydroponic plants

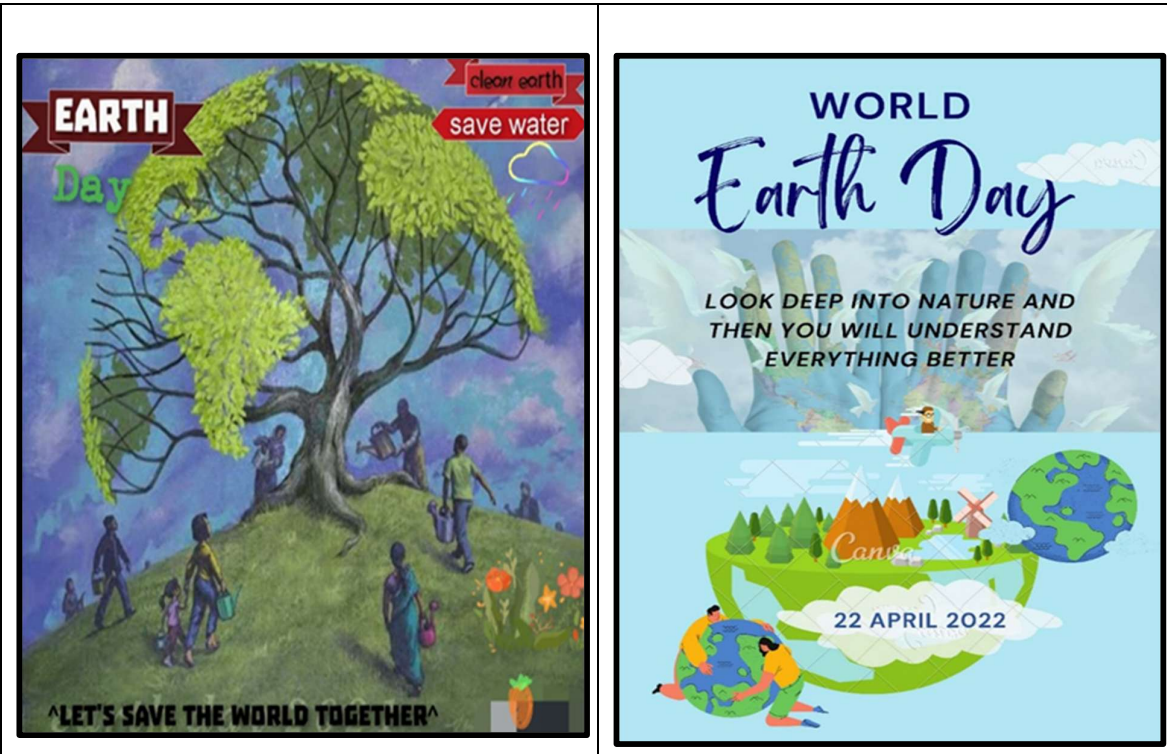

08.04.2022**

Water Conservation – Adopting a Few Habits Towards Water Conservation

Ms. Sonali Joshi, faculty member, conducted the program on Water Conservation. She began by welcoming everyone to the event. She covered the following points in her session:

Glass Half Full – as a practice at SVIMS, the water is served in the glasses only till the half level of the glass so as to ensure that even if a guest only sips water, there is not much water wastage.

Size of the glass – two glasses from the office pantry were taken and the water quantity was measured. One glass was short and the other one was taller. However, the water retaining quantity for both was the same. The perception of the size of the glass too makes a difference as to how people consider consumption of water.

Reusable Water Bottles – SVIMS does not support single use plastic. Therefore, all students and employees are advised to use reusable water bottles and refill the bottles as and when needed.

Half Flush – Full Flush – the attendees were also made aware of water conservation practices in the washrooms. The concept of Full flush and half flush was introduced to them.

Dripping Taps – The need to be observant and take actions towards dripping taps anywhere – roads, homes, gardens, offices – was reiterated. Every individual must feel responsible for closing any taps that may be found dripping or open without a purpose.

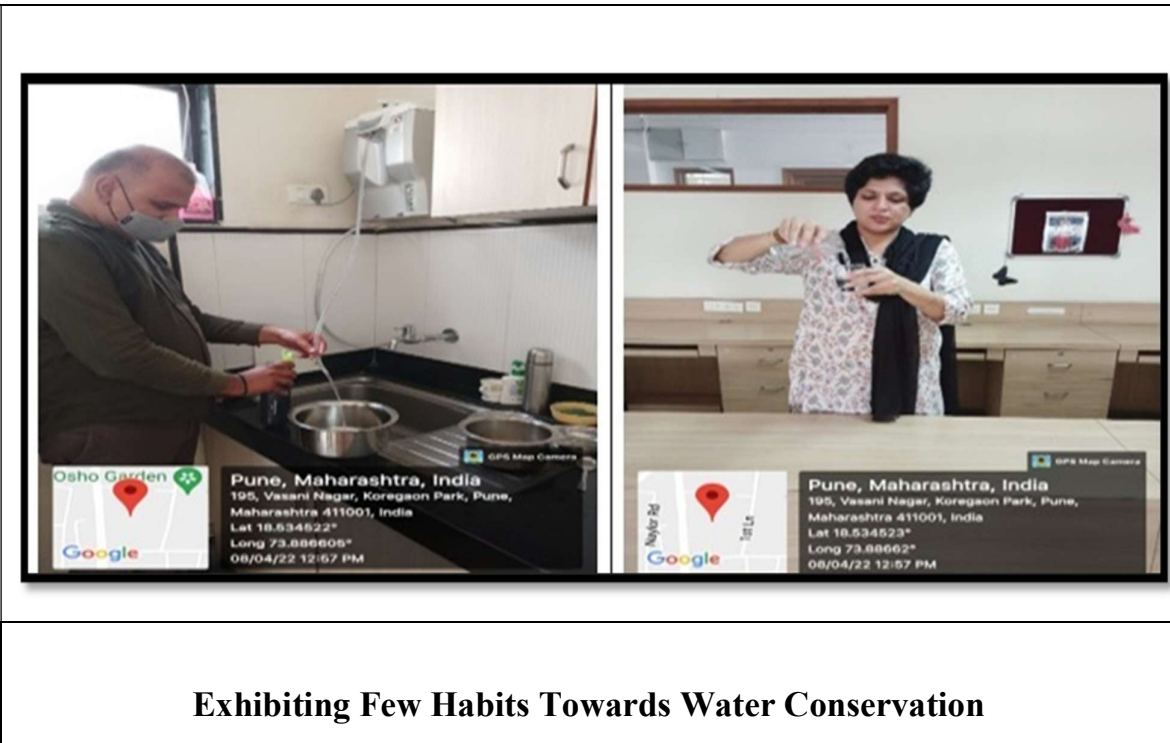
Filling up of Water from the Water Purifier– Bottles must be kept ready to be filled at the water purifier station in order to reduce wastage of water. The water from the machine should not be left open if there is a time lag between two bottles to be filled.

Reusing the Water – any water that has been left in glasses or in bottles must be accumulated in a bucket to be used for cleaning of the floors. If no

disinfectant has been put in such water, then the same water can be used to water the plants.

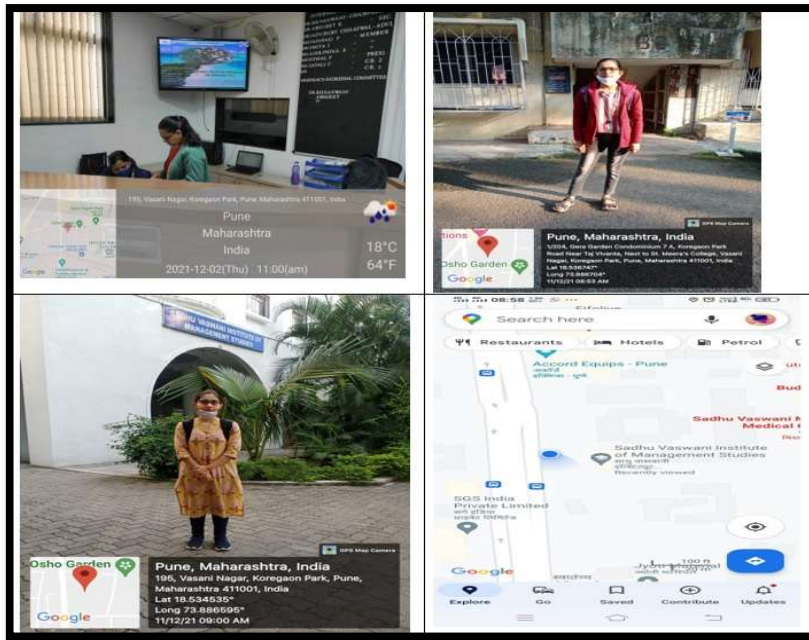

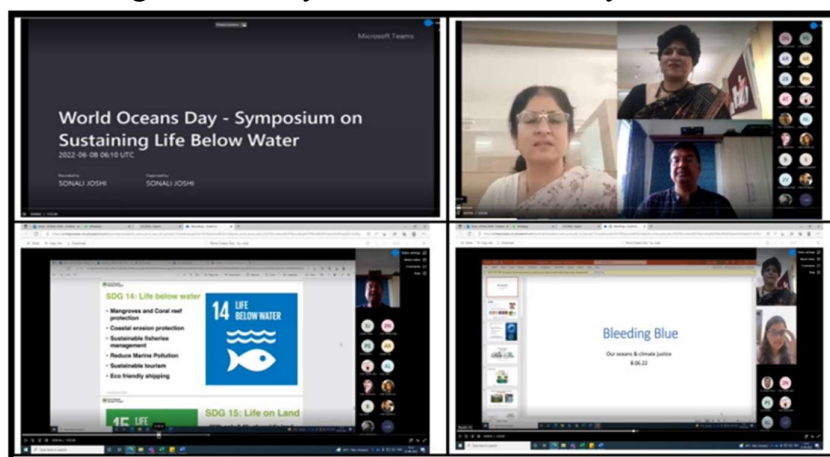
She began her session with quoting a narrative from Sir David Attenborough's documentary 'Blue Planet: Take a Deep Breath', "For years we thought the oceans were so vast and the inhabitants so infinitely numerous that nothing we could do could have an effect upon them. But now we know that was wrong," says Attenborough. "It is now clear our actions are having a significant impact on the world's oceans. [They] are under threat now as never before in human history. Many people believe the oceans have reached a crisis point."

Dr. Kashyap spoke extensively about the 14th UN SD Goal – Life below water. In India, about 35% of the population live within 100 km of the country's coastline measuring around 7500 km. Even though the sea level rise is a very slow phenomenon, the trends of sea level rise are estimated to be 1.3mm/year along the Indian coasts during the last 40 -50 years due to changes in the climate.

Dr. Kashyap put forth a few solutions to reduce the negative impact on the oceans and their life forms:

- Mangroves and Coral reef protection
- Coastal erosion protection
- Sustainable fisheries management
- Reduce Marine Pollution

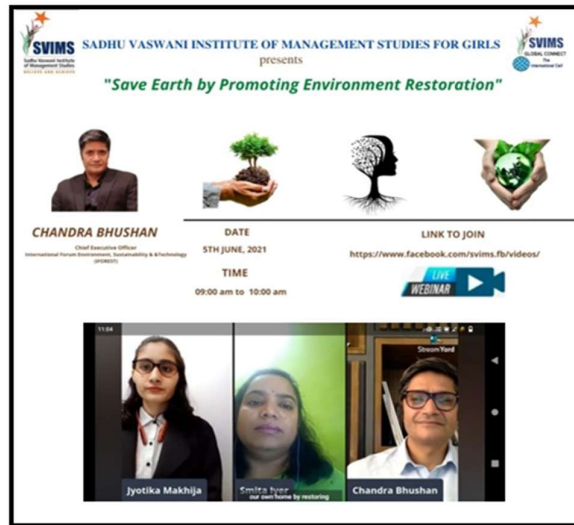

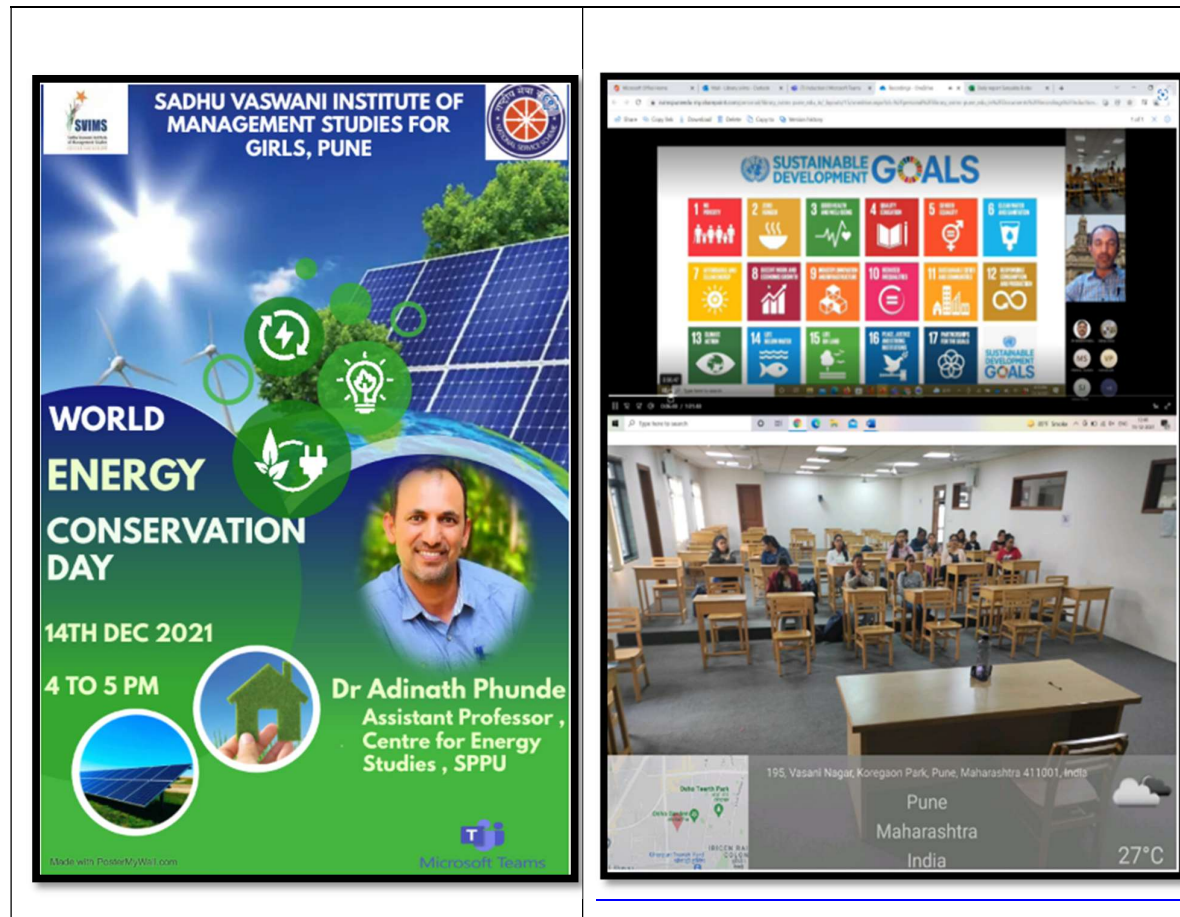
