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Waste Management Policy

Sadhu Vaswani Institute of Management Studies (SVIMS) is committed to promoting environmental sustainability and responsible waste management. This policy outlines our approach to the management of both degradable and nondegradable waste, with a focus on segregation, recycling, and responsible disposal practices.

1. Segregation of Waste:

- a. All waste generated within SVIMS premises shall be segregated into two main categories: dry waste and wet waste.
- b. Clearly labelled bins for dry and wet waste shall be provided at strategic locations throughout the institute.

2. Disposal of Sanitary Napkins:

- a. Sanitary napkins must be disposed of separately through designated incinerators to ensure proper and safe disposal.

3. Biogas Generation from Wet Waste:

- a. Wet waste, including kitchen waste and organic materials, shall be collected and sent to Inlaks & Budrani Hospital for the purpose of converting it into biogas.

4. Centralized E-waste Collection:

- a. E-waste, such as electronic cables and wires, will be centrally collected and handed over to designated agencies for proper disposal, adhering to all environmental regulations.

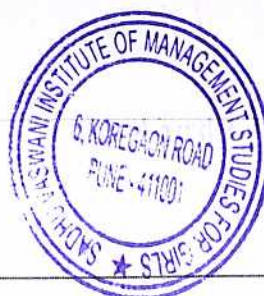
5. Recycling Initiatives:

- a. Newspapers and old SIP reports will be collected and sent to SWACH for recycling.
- b. Newspapers will also be donated to the Animal Shelter at Lila Parulekar Home for Animals.
- c. Old clothes, books, and toys will be donated to MAHER for the benefit of the underprivileged.

6. Responsible Disposal of Dry Waste:

- a. Dry waste, excluding recyclables, will be collected at a designated area within the institute and sent to Pune Municipal Corporation for proper disposal.

7. Brown Leaf Management:



a. Brown leaves will be disposed of responsibly through participation in the Brown Leaf forum, promoting eco-friendly management of dry leaves without resorting to burning.

8. Awareness and Training:

a. Regular awareness programs and training sessions shall be conducted to educate the SVIMS community about the importance of waste segregation and responsible disposal practices.


9. Monitoring and Compliance:
