






Deployment 5 – Curriculum Design


Deployment 1 - ICT Tool in Teaching

The students found the quiz to be a fun and interesting way to undertake their learning activity.






PADLET









Mindmeister / Coggle



Deployment 5 - Percentage of PhD holders to Full time Faculty Members


