

#### ABSTRACT

With the emergence of corona positive cases in India and reporting rising number of positive patients there was a threat to the mankind. The pandemic resulted in Lockdown 1 from 25th march which still continues. The organizations in India were not ready to face the challenges which involve remote working- work from home or work flexibility on the other part the IT sector continued the work from home smoothly. But work from home comes with lot of challenges; some enjoy it while some still feel maintaining a balance between work and home is far easier from the office than working from home.
