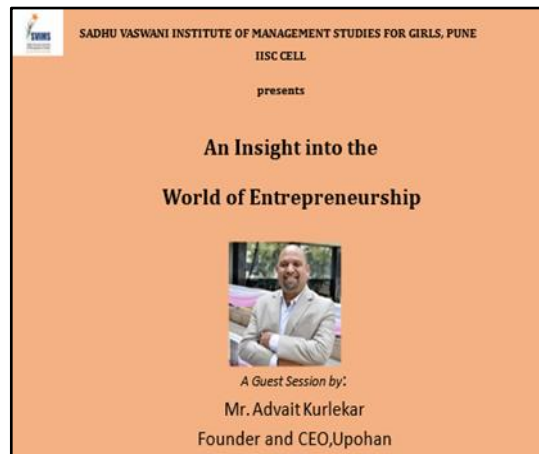

CMA Harshad Deshpande, Ex-Chairman – WIRC of ICAI, Insolvency Professional, Registered Valuer, explained about concept of corporate governance and its importance to companies. The case of ICICI Bank – Videocon was discussed wherein he emphasized on misuse of position by the directors. It was also discussed that this being a Related Party Transactions [RPT] it should have been dealt with utmost care and caution. In such situations the role played by independent directors in discharging their duties with due diligence plays an important role. They can demand requisite information from the company to arrive at correct decisions and if they are not satisfied, they can record their dissent. This is crucial as in the unfortunate event of foul play in such RPTs, independent directors can be held accountable. The lecture helped the students to understand the roles and responsibilities of the Directors towards the various scams that are happening and in the corporate governance.

She explained various job in Java, Java future, Skills to become a java developer. She also taught us about Spring Boot and its advantages and about Spring framework and Advantages of java. She said about relevance of java in 2023 As the world moves more towards mobile apps and convenience, Java is becoming more and more instrumental as a language. It's one of the strongest languages we see, ranked third most popular with recruiters in the last two years. It is widely recognized for its performance, platform independence, and security. Java is used as a server-side language for back-end development, android development, desktop computing, games, numerical computing, and contributing to advance technology.

She also informed – 10130 companies reportedly use Java in their tech stacks. The United States is the leader among the companies utilizing Java, with more than 60% market share of Java clients on a google search result.

She also told us about important concepts and tricks for IOT, AI , Android development. Ms. Aariya Parve gave the vote of thanks. Students were thus made aware that careers in IT require a strong foundation in JAVA.

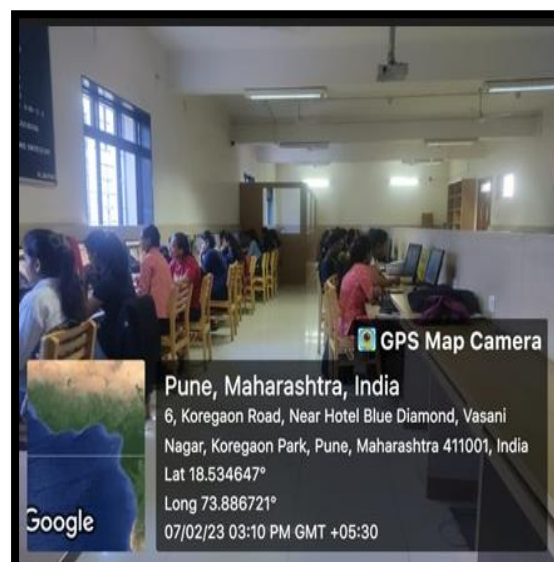
